Please DO NOT label supplies; teachers will label the necessary supplies for your child as needed

- Headphones (to keep at school) **No Earbuds**
- 12 or more glue sticks
- 24 #2 pencils, plain (*Ticonderoga preferred*)
- 2 pink erasers
- 2 boxes crayons, 24 count (*Crayola preferred*)
- 1 pair of scissors (blunt/round tip)
- 1 box facial tissue
- 1 composition books (*Mead Primary Journal preferred*)
- 1 package markers (A-L)
- 1 package watercolors (M-Z)

GRADE 1

Please DO NOT label supplies; teachers will label the necessary supplies for your child as needed

- Headphones (to keep at school) **No Earbuds**
- 12-24 #2 yellow pencils (*Ticonderoga preferred*)
- 1 pink eraser and/or package of pencil top erasers
- 3 or more boxes crayons, 24 count (*Crayola preferred*)
- 1 pair pointy scissors
- 20 or more glue sticks
- 1 small plain plastic supply box without dividers
- 1 box facial tissue
- \$10.00 classroom donation (optional)

One or more of the following:

- 1 box markers
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 fine point permanent marker, black, not extra fine (*Sharpie preferred*)
- 1-2 package baby wipes
- 1 package twistable crayons

GRADE 2

- 12-24 #2 yellow pencils, sharpened if possible
(*Ticonderoga preferred*)
- 1 or 2 pink erasers
- 2 boxes crayons, 24 count (*Crayola preferred*)
- 1 pair pointy scissors (*Fiskars preferred*)
- 10 or more glue sticks
- 1 small plain plastic supply box
- 1 box facial tissue
- 2 packages baby wipes
- \$10.00 donation for classroom (optional)

One or more of the following:

- 1 box markers
- 1 watercolor paint set (*Crayola preferred*)
- 1 fine point permanent marker, black, not extra fine (*Sharpie preferred*)

GRADES 3, 4 and 5 on reverse

- 1 box markers
- 1 ruler (standard and metric sides)
- 1 fine point permanent marker, black (*not ultra-fine*)
- 1 small school box
- 2 pocket folder
- 3 composition notebooks
- 1 large box facial tissue
- 1 container baby wipes

GRADE 4

Please DO NOT label supplies; teachers will label the necessary supplies for your child as needed

- Headphones or Earbuds (to keep at school)
- 4 composition books (9¾" x 7½", 100 pages, wide ruled)
- 48 #2 pencils, sharpened (*Ticonderoga preferred*)
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 pair scissors
- 12 glue sticks
- 2 large boxes facial tissue
- 2 containers baby wipes
- 3 packages dry erase markers

- 1 pencil bag/box
- 1 box markers
- 1 (2" inch) Binder
- 1 set of dividers
- \$10.00 classroom supplies donation (optional)

GRADE 5

Please DO NOT label supplies; teachers will label the necessary supplies for your child as needed

- Headphones or Earbuds (to keep at school)
- 1 package white college ruled notebook paper
- 3 composition books (2 lined + 1 graph)
- 24 #2 pencils, sharpened if possible (*Ticonderoga preferred*)
- 2 extra-fine point black markers (*Sharpie preferred*)
- 2 pocket folders
- 1 box colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 box of thin markers
- 1 package of 4 white board markers
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of large scissors
- 1 (2" inch) Binder
- 1 Set of Dividers

Recommended:

- 2 boxes facial tissue
- 1 container baby wipes
- 3 highlighters (1 green, 1 yellow, 1 pink)
- \$10.00 classroom supplies (optional)
