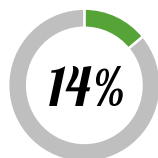

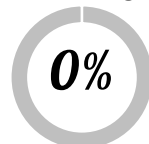

Our School

Barker Creek Community School—a new school of choice for our district—opened in fall 2017. The school was created within an existing building at the corner of McWilliams Road and Highway 303. Our school serves as a home for several programs that were previously offered as alternative programs. Students and families can choose a K-8 parent partnership program, 9-12 online academy and classroom-based instruction program for grades 9-12.

Success for All Students

Our school was created and is structured specifically to serve students whose educational needs may not be matched by more traditional K-12 school programs.

Due to the complex nature of our population, we work with each student on an individual basis. We have established a tradition of cooperation, appropriate classroom behavior, and pride in accomplishment.



With the increasing demands of student achievement testing, our program has focused on improving students' academic skills. This focus on improving student learning is reflected with improved test scores and more students meeting the standards. Our staff continues to assess their students' learning and align their training to better meet the needs of a unique student population.

State Testing Results

Our school continues to help students prepare for and meet the requirements of the High School Proficiency Exams (HSPE), Smarter Balanced Testing (SBA), and End of Course math and science exams (EOC).
