### About our school

Central Kitsap High School is a four-year comprehensive high school providing educational services to approximately 1,360 students. We are located on a forty-acre campus.

CKHS currently operates on a six-period day, allowing students flexibility to explore a variety of courses. The building is open for instructional purposes Monday through Wednesday from 6:45 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and until 3:30 p.m. Thursday and Friday. The school consists of 72 learning spaces.

With the passage of a bond in February 2016, construction for a new facility is now underway and is scheduled to open fall 2019. The replacement will add permanent classroom space to get students out of portables. State-of-the-art lab and career and technical areas will allow students to build skills for tomorrow's careers.

### Success for all students

We use a team approach to school improvement planning. The 12-member team includes representatives from each department and subject area who meet monthly throughout the year.

Staff analyzes current data and works toward teaching strategies with all students in mind. WCAP scores, SAT/ACT results, AP testing, discipline and attendance data are reviewed by staff members in small and large groups. Observations and narratives are crafted to formulate goals. Our growth initiatives focus on three themes: improving student engagement, improving the academic performance of under-represented populations, and making significant strides in technological advancements for teaching and learning. Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2016-17 school year, our daily attendance rate was 82.18 percent.
