

#### **Success for All Students**


We use a team approach to school improvement planning. The I2-member team includes representatives from each department and subject area who meet monthly throughout the year.

Staff analyzes current data and works toward teaching strategies with all students in mind. WCAP scores, SAT/ACT results, AP testing, discipline and attendance data are reviewed by staff members in small and large groups. Observations and narratives are crafted to formulate goals.
