Our dedicated staff of highly qualified professionals model what they teach and set continuing education as a high priority. As of 2016-17, our middle school model serves students in grades 6, 7 and 8. The 2015-16 school year was our last year serving only grades 7 and 8.

### About our school

Our school has an experienced staff of certificated teachers and classified support employees. Many members of our staff have specialized training, and 90% of our teachers have taught for five or more years.

We have 41 classrooms, a library, three computer labs, two gymnasiums, a cafeteria, and a separate band and choir facility with adjoining practice rooms.

Adjacent to the building are three athletic fields and a track. These resources are used for instruction Monday through Friday, 6:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. We put a great deal of effort into maintaining our aging building and providing the best environment possible for students and staff. We also house the district's Magnet program for middle school gifted students.



Central Kitsap Middle School is located just off of Anderson Hill Road on Frontier Place and is adjacent to Central Kitsap High School.

### Success for all students

Students in Washington are regularly tested by the state to assess their progress as they move through school. Last year at CKMS, students were tested in English Language Arts and math in grades 6, 7 and 8. Students in grade 8 were tested in science.

We set goals in the areas of science, math, literacy, music, technology and diversity. Along with an academically rigorous core

program, we offer a well-rounded, extensive selection of elective programs geared toward student interests. This includes several world language options; various fine and performing arts courses; interesting vocational options including manufacturing, computer programming, and food science; and special academic offerings such as leadership and Honor Society.

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2016-17 school year, our daily attendance rate was 93.35 percent.
