The school was built in 1978. Clear Creek has 24 classrooms for preschool through fifth grade, including six portable classrooms. Additionally, we have four district special education classrooms, a gym (multipurpose room) and a learning resource center. Our building is used from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for instructional purposes.

Success for All Students


During the 2017-18 school year, Clear Creek staff set goals for reading, writing, math and science. Each grade level team met six to eight times per year during Common Planning Time to evaluate student assessment data and to set goals based upon that data. This Common Planning Time included planning and aligning curriculum as well as creating assessment tools. Our staff also actively engages in staff development opportunities at the building and district level.
