About our school

Clear Creek Elementary is located just outside the Trigger Avenue Gate to the Naval Submarine Base, Bangor. The school was built in 1978. We have 24 preschool through sixth grade classrooms, four district special education classrooms, including six portable classrooms, a gym (multipurpose room) and a learning resource center. Our building is used from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for

instructional purposes. Our enrollment nears 580 students. Our staff consists of classroom teachers, paraeducators, specialists and support staff. Our teaching staff ranges from 1-34 years of teaching experience. Our staff actively engages in staff development opportunities at the building and district level.

Success for all students

During the 2014-15 school year, Clear Creek staff set goals for reading, writing, math and science. Each grade level team met six to eight times per year during Common Planning Time to evaluate student assessment data and to set goals based upon that data. This Common Planning Time included planning and aligning curriculum as well as creating assessment tools.

In the fall, we reviewed the results of the state tests called the "Smarter Balanced Assessments" and Measurements of Student Progress (MSP). Students are tested in reading, writing, math and science. You may view our results online

at <http://reportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>. Parent involvement is a strong component of a Title I School. We are interested in strengthening this partnership. Last year, we had an excellent turnout for Open House, Conferences and our PTA Family Nights.

We like to remind families that good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2014-15 school year, our daily attendance rate was 92.0%.
