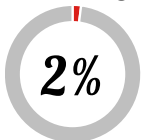

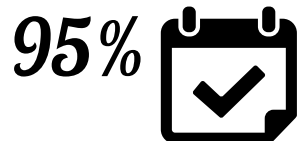

Our School

Cougar Valley Elementary School opened in the fall of 1989. Last year, our enrollment was approximately 480 students. The instructional program begins at 9:10 a.m. and ends at 3:25 p.m. each day.

Cougar Valley has 22 classrooms and 4 portable classrooms. Our school has a library, music room, gym, and a multipurpose room that is used for lunch and special programs, including assemblies. There are four special education classrooms, and the building and playground are equipped to provide access for students with special needs.

Success for All Students

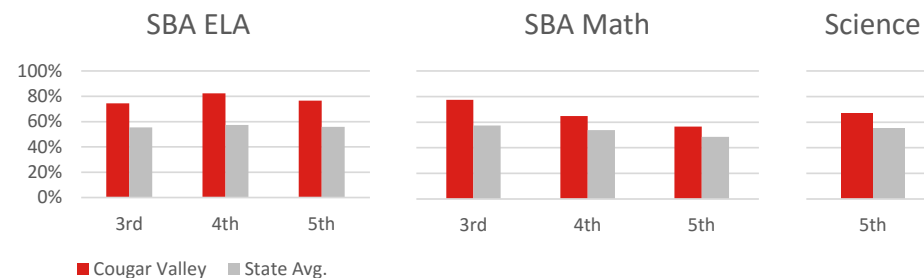
