Emerald Heights has many special programs to help broaden each child's school experience.

Emerald Heights Elementary opened in 1993. The building now serves students in preschool through grade five. The building is used for instruction from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the school year.

Emerald Heights is a two-story building with the library located in the middle as our "resource center" for student learning.

There are 25 kindergarten through 5th grade classrooms (including portables), support service spaces, library, gym, music room, learning center, handicapped preschool, and daycare.

Emerald Heights is also the home for the district's elementary gifted program, which serves students in grades two through five.

Success for all students

Our School Improvement Plan (SIP) is developed from that process. Our SIP includes strategies to help all students improve their performance.

Teachers participate in a variety of staff development activities designed to

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2016-17 school year, our daily attendance rate was 94.31 percent.
