About our school

Emerald Heights Elementary opened in 1993. The building currently serves about 640 students in preschool through grade six. The building is used for instruction from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. during the school year.

Emerald Heights is a two-story building with the library located in the middle as our "resource center" for student learning.

There are 25 kindergarten through 6th grade classrooms (including portables), support service spaces, library, gym, music room, learning center, handicapped preschool, and daycare.

Emerald Heights is also the home for the district's elementary gifted program, which serves students in grades two through six.
