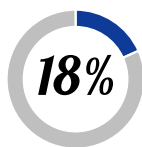

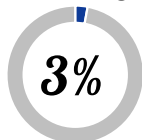

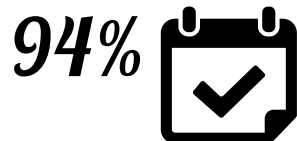

Success for All Students

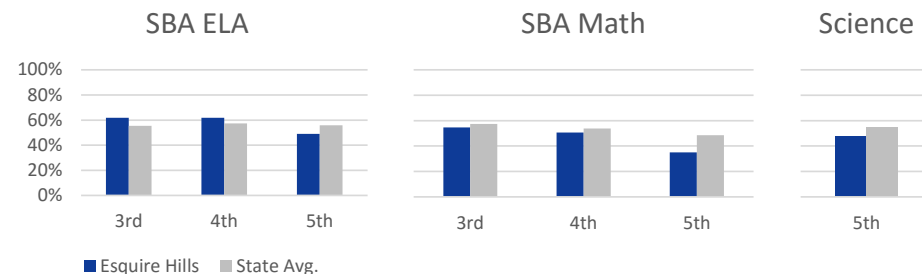
