

Fairview has 36 rooms, a gymnasium and spacious library. The school has a robust technology program, including state of the art learning opportunities for students who desire to pursue careers in computers and aviation.


## Success for All Students

As part of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, schools must complete an annual School Improvement Plan, in which they review, evaluate, and set goals for academic improvement.
