Fairview has 36 rooms, a gymnasium, and a modern library with updated resources and multiple computer stations with wireless-Internet capability. The school also has four computer labs which provide the very latest technology for our students. The Applied Technology Laboratory provides state-of-the-art learning opportunities for students who desire to pursue careers in computers and

modern manufacturing techniques. Additionally, Fairview will begin an innovative robotics class for students during the 2015-16 school year.

Built in 1971, our school has seen significant building improvements over the past five years. This includes the completion of a new roof, exterior painting, a science classroom remodel and a new gymnasium floor.
