During the 2017-18 school year, our staff focused on increasing student engagement and improving reading achievement through culturally responsive strategies that maximize learning time and student potential. We are training to become a Trauma-Informed school that utilizes multi-tiered systems of supports to address social-emotional and academic needs of students. Families are invited to our Back-to-School Curriculum Night in August and Community Engagement Nights throughout the year.

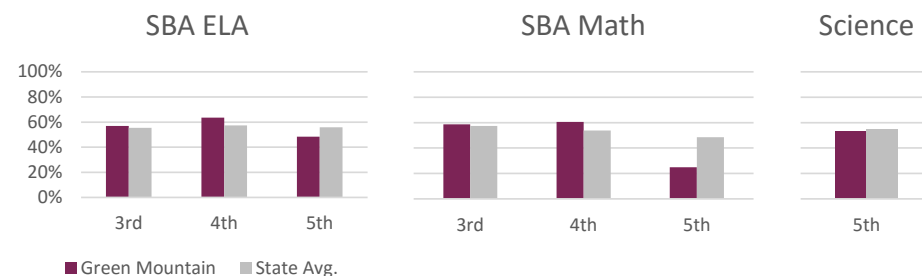
Our School

Our school hosts OESD's Head Start and CKSD's Developmental PreK programs, Special Ed and Gifted/Highly Capable service, and 5th Grade Band and Orchestra. Each student participates in P.E., Music and Media Specialist instruction as a part of our school day. We are a Future-Ready School where students experience blended learning via 1:1 Chromebook devices. Extended day activities include 2nd Grade Reading Intervention, Unicycle Team, Choir, Safety Patrol, Girls on the Run, and WE Club.

Our school day is 9:10 am - 3:25 pm, except on Early Release Thursdays when students are dismissed at 1:55 pm. Staff utilize Thursday afternoons to meet in Professional Learning Communities for training, data discussions, and instructional planning aligned to building/district goals. Non-student Days are also used for staff professional development. We are committed to continuous improvement, student recognition and safety.
