### About our school

Situated on an 80-acre wooded site, Klahowya Secondary School is the third and newest high school and the fourth and newest middle school in Central Kitsap School District. Klahowya opened in 1997. Beginning in the 2016-17 school year, we welcomed sixth grade students to our school, making Klahowya the only 6-12 school in the district.

The school has 33 classrooms, 18 portable classrooms, a gym, a common

area, an auditorium with stage, a music room, a graphics room, a library, athletic fields, and support areas. Klahowya uses technology as a tool for teaching and learning with five classrooms equipped with 30 work stations.

With the passage of a bond in 2016, we are building an addition that will include classroom spaces, an auxiliary gym and a second music room.
