## Our School

Olympic High School opened in September of 1979 and is accredited by the Northwest Accreditation Commission. Recently, the center portion of the high school was demolished to make way for technical education classrooms, library, auditorium and commons area. Improvements were made possible with the passage of a bond in February 2016,

Olympic currently operates on a six-period day and offers a wide variety of courses to serve our students' needs. We offer a modified schedule two days per week to accommodate a 47-minute Advisory or Tutorial period each of those days.

## Success for All Students

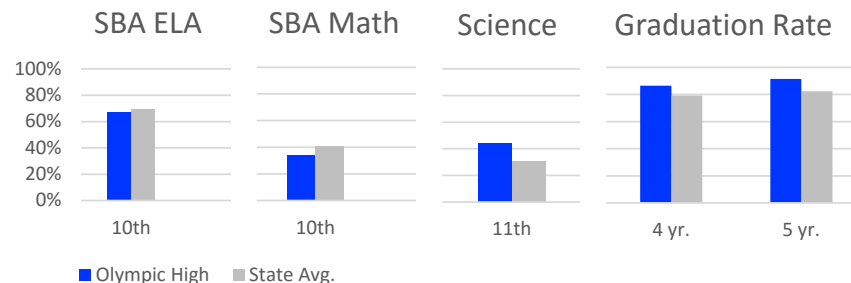
Our School Improvement Plan is focused on increasing the percentage of students meeting state standards. While percentages change from year to year based upon student cohorts and revisions to the test, we continue our work ensuring students learn the state standards and can demonstrate their proficiency.

Our Advanced Placement (AP) and honors programs raise standards in all classes to ensure students have a rigorous course of study. Many students are taking AP classes and exams to earn college credit. Enrollment in AP courses and the percentage of students taking the AP exam increased significantly. Our honors program provides challenging opportunities for sophomores.
