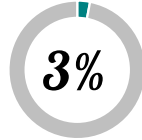

PineCrest is a two-story building, with the library located in the center as the resource center for our students' learning. Last year, there were 21 K-5 classrooms, a special education preschool, gym, library, music room, and various small office spaces for staff, students and our PTA.

Our building is used for student instruction between 8:20 a.m. and 2:35 p.m., except Thursdays when students are dismissed at 1:05 p.m. We have a before and after school daycare program that is sponsored by the YMCA.

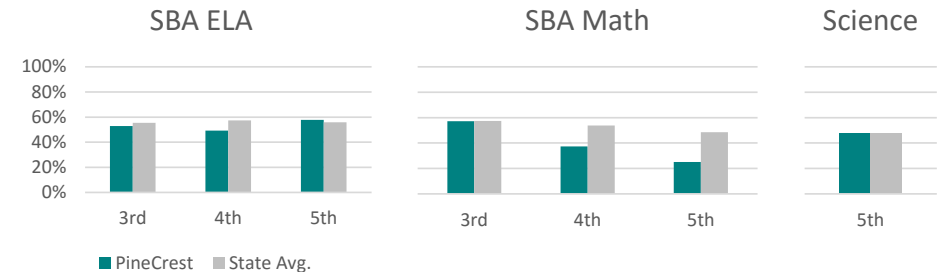
We will continue to analyze our students' achievement indicators to guide further improvement efforts.
