About our school

PineCrest Elementary opened in 1998. We served 505 students in preschool through sixth grade during 2014-15 school year. Our building is used for student instruction between 8:20 a.m. and 2:35 p.m., except Thursdays when students are dismissed at 1:05 p.m. We have a before and after school daycare program that is sponsored by the YMCA and HeadStart, ECEAP programs.

PineCrest is a two-story building, with the library located in the center as the resource center for our students' learning. There are 21 K-6 classrooms, a special education preschool, gym, library, music room, and various small office spaces for staff, students and our PTA. Our experienced staff is committed to collaboration and ongoing professional development.



Built in 1998, PineCrest Elementary sits on a 17.34 acre site. The school itself is 58,000 square feet.

Success for all students

Each fall, we review the results of the state test called the SBA, "Smarter Balance Assessment." Students are tested in reading, writing, math and science. You may view our results online at <http://reportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>.

We consider these results, as well as a variety of other data, to see how our students performed. Using this information, we review and refine our School Improvement Plan. Our goals are to ensure the academic and social growth of each child. Literacy and math are always emphasized. We also set goals in the areas of science, diversity, parent engagement, and technology.

Extended learning opportunities are provided to students needing extra support in reading and math. These learning opportunities are provided in a variety of venues by our instructional staff, our learning specialist, and the principal. We will continue to analyze our students' achievement indicators to guide further improvement efforts.

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2014-15 school year, our daily attendance rate was 93.0%.
