Silver Ridge opened in 1990 with an emphasis on incorporating many of the best practices in education. Students (grades K-6) receive a rigorous education in an open concept environment.

We emphasize character education while holding students to high academic standards. Students have ready access to technology to

enhance their learning and prepare them for future opportunities.

Currently, our building houses 18 classrooms, TEAM Multiage program, and a year-round day care program open from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. The building also incorporates space for library, music, art, and physical education activities.

Success for all students

Each fall, we review the results of the state test called the SBA, "Smarter Balanced Assessment." Students are tested in reading, writing, math and science. You may view our results online at <http://reportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>.

We use these results as we consider our School Improvement Plan and set goals for the year. During the 2014-2015 school year, we focused on continued improvement in reading and writing. We have a rigorous intervention program in both reading a writing. We are dedicated to analyzing student data and making adjustments to classroom instruction. Teachers also worked on

using formative and summative assessment data to inform instruction for all students.

Together with support from the district, we also focused on closing the achievement gap. Our work with a consultant and our district Diversity Specialist helped us to implement strategies that helped guide us all in meeting the needs of our diverse population.

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2014-15 school year, our daily attendance rate was 93.7%.
