Each fall, we review the results of the state test called the SBA, "Smarter Balanced Assessment." Students are tested in reading, writing, math and science. You may view our results online at http://reportcard.ospi.kl2.wa.us.

We use these results as we consider our School Improvement Plan and set goals for the year. During the 2016-17 school year, we focused on continued improvement in reading and also placed an emphasis on writing instruction and math fact fluency. We have a rigorous intervention program in both reading and math. We are dedicated to analyzing student data and making adjustments to

classroom instruction. Teachers also worked on using formative and summative assessment data to inform instruction for all students.

With support from the district, we also focused on closing the achievement gap. Our work with a consultant and our district diversity specialist helped us implement strategies to guide us in meeting the needs of our diverse population.

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2016-17 school year, our daily attendance rate was 95.55 percent.
