Silverdale Elementary opened in 1979 and underwent a major remodel during the 2015-16 school year. After spending a year at “host schools” students were excited to return back to our building for the 2016-17 school year.

We have two district-level programs and two to three classes per grade level (K- 5). The original building has 21 classrooms, a multipurpose room, a gym, a stage, a learning center, speech and language rooms and other offices, the office (including the health room), and our library.

Success for All Students


