About our school

Silverdale Elementary opened in 1979 and is undergoing a major remodel during the 2015-16 school year. We have two district-level programs and two to three classes each in grades K-6. During the 2014-15 school year, we moved from a half-day to a full-day kindergarten model. We are excited about the possibilities for our newest Dolphins! The original building has 21 classrooms, a multipurpose room, a

gym, a stage, a learning center, speech and language rooms and other offices, the office (including the health room), and our library. We also have four portables, which house band and music, a preschool class, and another computer lab. As we undergo our remodel, there will be some significant changes made to improve learning spaces as well as a more updated and welcoming office and school front.



Silverdale Elementary is being remodeled thanks to CKSD voters who approved the 2011 Capital Projects Levy. The building will reopen in fall 2016.

Success for all students

Silverdale's staff is committed to the success of each of our students. Our school improvement plan is focused on specific goals in reading, writing, mathematics, science, diversity and family and community involvement. The focus in each of our classrooms is to provide instruction in the basic skills in reading, writing, math, social studies and science and to provide expansion, exploration and remediation opportunities for each student.

At the beginning of each year, our staff meets to analyze the state and district assessment data from the previous school year, and to collaboratively plan

Connecting with families is important to our students' success, so we provide regular updates on learning progress, homework and behavior. We emphasize the need to honor and support each family's unique cultural experiences.

Good attendance is a great way to promote success in school. During the 2014-15 school year, our daily attendance rate was 92.4%.
