## About our school

Woodlands Elementary School opened in 1981. During the 2016-17 school year, we served approximately 380 students in grades K-5. Our building has 23 classrooms and is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The main building has a gym, library, classrooms in pods, special education rooms, music room, computer lab,

speech/language room, health room, staff work rooms, and an office/administrative area. The three instructional pods each have six classrooms. A portable building with two rooms contains childcare and a preschool. Adjacent to the building are a covered play area, a playground, and athletic fields.

## Success for all students

In the classroom, our focus is on meeting the challenging goals of:

- ▶ building relationships that support learning
- ▶ developing skills and knowledge of concepts
- ▶ engaging all students in relevant, high quality instruction
- ▶ providing instruction that has a real-world connection

Each fall, we review the results of the state testing called Smarter Balanced. Students are tested in ELA and math. Fifth graders take the MSP Science test. You may view our results online at <http://reportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>.

As a staff, we use these results—and other state, district and school assessments—to target instruction. We provide struggling students with academic interventions during the school day which are designed to meet each child's needs.

Linking our families and the community to Woodlands is very important to student success. Teachers provide families with information about their child's learning, homework, and behavior. Good attendance is a great way for families to promote success. During the 2016-17 school year, our daily attendance rate was 94.04 percent.
