STEP TWO

Write a concise description of your proposal (300-500 words). Be sure to include how your proposal relates to your school's academic or leadership goals and how it will benefit both you and your school.

STEP THREE

Include a statement explaining why it is important for you to receive assistance from the Paul Linder Educational Foundation.

STEP FOUR

Complete the top portion of this application and return all documents (including this application) bound together by a paper clip rather than stapled. If your request is technology related, this application must be signed by the Department of Information Services Director.

If your proposal is funded, you will be asked to complete an online summary upon completion of the project. The summary will describe the results of your proposal. The information provided will be used in fundraising drives to illustrate how Paul Linder Educational Foundation Grants further educational excellence. Additionally, you may be asked to present your program at the Foundation's annual meeting. Reports are due no later than **May 29, 2020**.
