Success for All Students

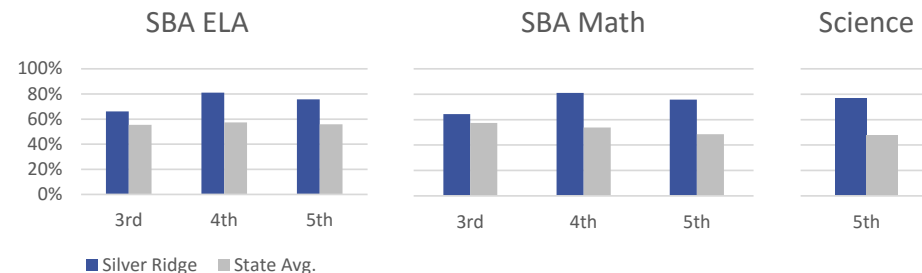
