**Subject:** District Status Update



Our recent [Thoughtexchange process](#) was a good way for me to find out how you're doing, as well as what's been working, and what hasn't. One thing we heard is that we need to do a **better job with more timely communications**—*even when we don't have all the answers*. In response, we have developed this bi-weekly status update on key areas. ### Special Ed Re-entry

**Happening Now:** Our self-contained special education students were the first to return for in-person instruction. Secondary self-contained students started on October 15, and elementary started on October 19.

**What's Next:** We will continue slowly phasing in our special education students. The next group of special education students will return on November 9.

### Secondary Re-entry

**Happening Now:** Most of our 6-12 students will remain in a fully remote learning model until at least the end of first semester (January 28).

**What's Next:** Some small groups of students in grades 6-12 may begin transitioning during first semester (such as students who need intensive academic support.) We are working on plans for what the second semester will look like.

### Elementary Re-entry

**Happening Now:** On November 9, we will welcome our preschool, kindergarten and 1st grade students back for in-person instruction. We updated the *Remote + In-Person Family Guidebook* with a [revised version containing new information for elementary families](#).

**What's Next:** We are finalizing plans to phase back our students in grades 2-3 (likely December) and 4-5 (likely January).

### Secondary Athletics

**Happening Now:** From November 2 through Thanksgiving break, high school students and coaches may participate in outdoor conditioning activities.

**What's Next:** Sports-specific pre-practice will be held November 30-December 18. The next WIAA [modified sports season](#) for the 2020-21 school year begins December 28.



## District Budget

**Happening Now:** Our enrollment is down, which will impact our funding. At the same time, our spending is also down in some areas but up in others. We shared [this 2020-21 budget presentation](#) with our school board during the October 14 study session.

**What's Next:** We will share a budget update with the school board on November 10.



## Staff Wellness

**Happening Now:** Have you seen our [Family Wellness Site](#)? It's loaded with tips and information to help families find balance in the 2020-21 school year.

**What's Next:** Healthy habits can help our students *and* staff manage mental and physical stress. So be sure to take time for yourself, too!
