COMMUNITY RELATIONS

School-Support Organizations

The Board recognizes the valuable services performed by the Parent - Teacher - Student Association (PTSA), booster clubs, and other groups that cooperate closely with schools in support of students.

The Board encourages the formation of a PTSA or similar organization at each school building for the purpose of providing opportunities through which parents, staff, and students may unite their efforts to enhance school programs. In schools where no such organization exists, another parent group can be recognized by the school principal as the official body through which parents, staff, and students may unite their efforts for similar purposes.

The Board recommends that the Council of the PTSA and other school support groups maintain a close liaison with the Board, building and District administration, and staff and recognize established District policies.

Booster clubs and/or other organizations may be formed to support and strengthen specific activities conducted within the school or District. All such groups must receive the approval of the school principal or superintendent in order to be recognized as a booster organization. Staff participation, cooperation, and support are encouraged in such recognized organizations.

All events and fundraising must be coordinated with school officials annually. Conflicts with ASB-sponsored activities or other previously approved groups must be resolved before planning proceeds.
