## School Supply List

Klahowya students do not have lockers so it is recommended that ALL students carry their supplies and personal items in a backpack or messenger-style bag.


## Suggested School Supplies

## PE Uniforms

Students should wear shorts, shirts and shoes that are comfortable. Students wishing to wear a sweatshirt or sweatpants are encouraged to wear school colors (green, black or gray). White cotton sweat socks and a pair of lace-up athletic shoes (with good arch support) are also recommended. Locks and baskets will be issued the first day of the semester. Students will be fined $\$ 7$ for any lock not returned at the end of the semester.

## Advanced Placement (AP) Fees

Each AP course will have a test fee of $\$ 98^{*}$ (reduced fees are available for qualifying students). A deposit for each test is due by early fall and the balance is due by early spring. There may also be textbook or workbook fees. Please check with individual AP teachers for those costs.

## ASB Card

All students who participate in any school sport will be required to purchase an ASB card. The high school (grades 9-12) ASB fee is $\$ 50$. The middle school (grades 6-8) ASB fee is $\$ 30$. There are no athletic fees for the 2023-24 school year.

## Parking Permit

Each student who drives a car to school will be required to park in the student parking lot. Each student-driven car parked at school requires a permit, which costs \$5.
